## IS YOUR CHILD ELIGIBLE FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS?

All Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils are entitled to a Free School Meal. **Pupils moving into Year 3 in September will no longer be eligible for a Free School Meal, unless their parents are in receipt of qualifying benefits.** If you think your child is eligible for Free School Meals in September please contact the Education Office on 01254-220711. Unless the school receives notification from the Education Office, you will be charged for any meals taken by your child.

**Even if your child does not want a school dinner, and prefers sandwiches, if you are entitled to claim Free School Meals, please do so as the school will receive additional funding that can be spent on your child.**

**School closes at 2.00 p.m. on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July. The new school year begins at 9.00 a.m. on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> September.**
