OPEN AFTERNOONS AND CRAFT DAYS:

During the recent Open Afternoons it appeared that some Y3 parents expected to work with children other than their own. This confusion may have arisen because the Craft Days that have taken place when your child was in Key Stage 1 e.g. Christmas Crafts or the Easter Eggstravaganza are planned for every child to take part irrespective of whether a parent or grandparent can attend. This can result in one adult working with several children including their own child.

By contrast, the Class Open Afternoons are specifically for parents or occasionally grandparents to find out about the work being done by their child or grandchild by sharing some of their learning experiences with them. They are not intended to involve all children. For this reason it has always been the case that a parent works with their own child and those children whose parents cannot attend are engaged in other activities elsewhere in the building. Hopefully this will clear up the confusion.
