

DINNER MONEY PAYMENTS

A reminder to those parents concerned that outstanding dinner money must be paid at the school office, in line with the arrangements outlined in the reminder letter that was sent out this week.

If payment of any outstanding balance will cause problems please speak to Mrs Singleton in the school office to arrange a more manageable payment schedule.

As from Monday 18th June 2018 Lancashire County Council Policy on dinner money payment and arrears will be implemented. This means that if arrears exceed £33 (3 weeks) the school will not provide a meal and the parent must provide a packed lunch for their child. Payment for meals taken must also be made in advance.

It is the responsibility of parents to check with the Area Education Office whether their child is entitled to Free School Meals in Key Stage 2. Eligibility can change if family circumstances change, and parents have to re-apply periodically to ensure any entitlement to Free School Meals continues. Telephone details for the Area Education Office can be obtained from the school office.
