## **SCHOOL ATTENDANCE:**

The school attendance figure for this school is year is 96.3% across all year groups. This represents a good level of attendance. A number of children have achieved 100% attendance during the year and the very large majority of children have had very good attendance (above 97%).

Good attendance gives your child the best possible opportunity to learn and to make good progress.

Unfortunately, a small number of children have attendance rates which are not acceptable. If your child received a red notification certificate with their end of year report, this means that their attendance was inadequate this year. It will be essential that these children's attendance significantly improves this coming school year.

It should be noted that allowing a child to miss school without a valid reason is now seen as child neglect by denying them their right to education, and as such could lead to the involvement of Children's Social Care in taking action against parents who allow this to happen.
