SCHOOL UNIFORM

It has been lovely to see the children looking very smart in the school uniforms this week. Please make sure that you write their name or at the very least their initials in the different parts of their uniform, especially in their sweatshirt or cardigan. This will greatly increase the chance of any misplaced clothing finding its way back to the correct child.

For the benefit of new parents and to remind all parents a few of our expectations for school uniform are listed below;

Shoes should be worn for school. Trainers should not be worn, unless your child's school shoes are temporarily unavailable.

P.E. kit should be kept in school. This should include a plain T-shirt, shorts and pumps. There is no requirement for the kit to be white but we do ask that your child's T-shirt is one colour e.g. no striped T-shirts or multi-coloured shorts etc.

Pupils in Year 4 and Year 5 have a weekly swimming lesson. This is part of the P.E. curriculum and all pupils must take part. A single piece swimming costume is needed for girls and boys should wear trunks or lycra-type swimming shorts. Long or baggy beach shorts are not allowed to be worn. Children with long hair are required to wear a swimming cap.

Stud-type earrings may be worn for school. The earring must be small and round in shape. Any other design or shape of earring is not allowed. Necklaces, rings or bracelets cannot be worn for school.
