## ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT MRS WARBURTON

Mrs Warburton has informed the governing board of the school of her intention to retire from her post as Deputy Head Teacher at the end of the Spring Term 2021.

Mrs Warburton previously taught at Tunstead C.E.P.S. before it merged with Western C.P. to become Holy Trinity in 1987, meaning that she has spent the entire 45 years of her teaching career serving the children of Stacksteads and their families, and many of you reading this announcement will have been taught by her.

The plans to mark her well-earned retirement at the end of March will be passed on to you during the Spring Term.

The plan is to hold the meetings before the end of this term, but one or two bubbles may have to hold their meetings early next term, depending on the number of parents requesting appointments, as only one bubble will be holding meetings on any single day.
