Your child's teacher will send a reply to your email with the confirmed time of the telephone appointment. Please be ready to take the call 5-minutes before it is due.

Telephone appointments will be 5-minutes long. In order to keep meetings on schedule, this time-limit must be adhered to.

PARENT PAY REMINDER

We will be switching to Parent Pay on Wednesday 1st December, when it will no longer be possible to pay for things by bank transfer into the school bank account.

On Wednesday 24th November you will receive your ParentPay Activation Code in a letter. If you have more than one child you will receive a separate Activation Code for each. You will be able to link all of your children into one account after you have activated an account for each of them.

The final date for bank transfers will be Tuesday 30th November. It will be very helpful if all outstanding balances are settled by 30th November, so that every child starts with a nil balance in ParentPay.

During the changeover week, bank transfer should be used to pay for school meals etc for Monday and Tuesday, and ParentPay should then be used to pay for school meals for the rest of the week, and beyond.
