Next term we will be assessing the children against the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Early Learning Goals. We will decide if the children have reached the expected standard in 17 areas at the end of Reception. The 17 Early Learning Goals are attached.

We will hold a parents' meeting on **Wednesday 19th April at 3pm** in the Reception classroom to discuss this assessment.

Then we will hold parents' meetings in school to discuss each child on **Monday 24th April 1pm-6pm**. Please complete the attached slip for your meeting.

Some of our routines will change after Easter to help with our assessments and to develop the children's independence and confidence.

<u>PE</u>

The children will get changed for PE in school to practise their self-help skills.

Please send them with a named PE kit in a named bag to keep at school.

Our PE kit is:

Plain t-shirt, plain shorts/joggers, plain pumps, NO earrings.

Lunchtime

We will start to take the children into the hall for their lunches.

They will choose what they would like from the menu in the morning. At lunchtime they will collect and eat their lunch in the hall. Their familiar teachers will be with them for this.

Reading Books

We will send 3 books home each Monday.

They will have already read one of these books in school. They should know this book well and should be more fluent with it. Please continue to read this more familiar book alongside the less familiar books to help the children's confidence and fluency.

It is good for them to read and reread known books. We will read with them every day in school but will only change their home reading books on a Monday. The children have access to books on active learn if you would like to read more books with your child.
